Prayer concerns for Nagy's while in Kenya,
February 1– April 11th, 2010

- Safe travel to and from Kenya—and while in Kenya
- We are able to make the connection in London—only 1 hour layover
- All 6 trunks with medical supplies, etc. arrive intact
- Health and adequate strength for what needs to be done
- We are able to find children who need solar powered hearing aids
- Some of the children who have received hearing aids in the past return for follow-up
- That Rose will be able to interpret again this year for Bob
- Sensitivity to when and how we should pray with the patients
- Ginger might be able to continue a Bible Study with Jane
- Be able to develop some new friendships—and grow in old ones
- Help Tom Boeve (newly arrived full time ENT surgeon) and his family adjust to life in Kijabe
- Opportunity to visit with the Bouchards
- Continued rains & good crops this year in Kenya
- Peace in Kenya
- Ginger able to have a cell phone again this year (to contact Bob when needed at the ENT clinic)
- An opportunity to visit Tenwik Hospital in Western Kenya

Prayer concerns for Nagy's while in Kenya,
February 1-April 11, 2010

- Surgical procedures go smoothly and have successful outcomes
- Bob will be able to provide some continuing education for the staff
- Patients come to the clinic that Bob can help
- Opportunities to share the Gospel and to pray with patients
- Ginger finds ways to do the string ministry with kids and adults
- That we will be able to get together with Ray Focht, Shikuku and his family
- Able to visit the 3 children we are sponsoring through Compassion in Kenya. (Virginia—7, Grace—6 1/2, and Agostino —15)
- Work well with Cleft Lip and Palate Team when they arrive in early March
- Know how best to respond to the needs that come to our attention. e.g. requests for help
- Know how best to relate to other families and individuals in the Sitaplex (sixplex—where we stay in Kenya)
- That Ginger would be able to help with the Awana Clubs in Kijabe
