Colter & Anna Brown



Colter & Anna Brown work with CEF (Child Evangelism Fellowship) in Honduras. They have recently returned to the capitol city of Tegucigalpa after a mandated evacuation. Their health is good and they are settled in and are beginning to resume their ministry.

Please pray for Colter & Anna...

Praise: They have recently found a rental on the outskirts of Tegucigalpa with parking. (They were staying in the inner city with Anna's grandparents. Each night, they had to drop the car off at a parking garage, pay the attendant and then walk 1.5 miles home. During the day, Colter had to constantly check the car and watch it to guard against thieves.)

Praise & Prayer: They will be starting back teaching in the public schools. They continue to work on starting a strong Christina Youth in Action program to train the teens to reach children.

Praise: God took care of Colter in a recent traffic incident.

Prayer: Please pray that Colter would be able to secure the car title for CEF, that he would be able to get official papers that make him a resident of Honduras.
