## **“THE MYSTERY”**

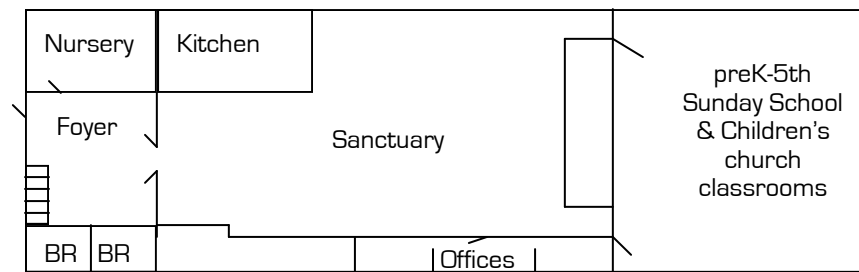
“For God so loved the world, that He gave his one and only Son that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life. “ John 3:16

God is holy, just and loving. He created us and wants us to be with him forever. The problem is sin—the bad things we do keep us apart from our holy & just God. He had a plan though: God came to earth in the form of a person - Jesus Christ. Jesus lived and walked among us and willingly gave up His life dying a horrible death on the cross to pay the penalty for all of our sins. He rose from the dead after 3 days proving He is indeed God.

When you believe and trust that Jesus died for your sins, (accepting the forgiveness he offers and deciding to follow Him), Jesus promises to forgive you and give you eternal life.
