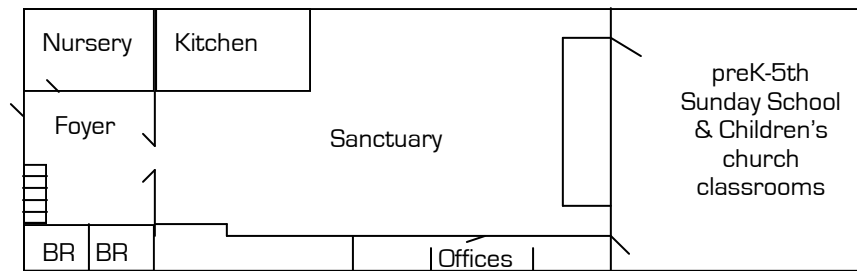
“For God so loved the world, that He gave his one and only Son that whoever believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life. “ John 3:16
