

## **Quiet Time Study: John 11: 1-16**

**\*Pray:** Acknowledge to the LORD that He is your shepherd. Ask Him to guide you in paths of righteousness. (Psalm 23:1, 3)

**\*Read:** Read through John 11:1-44 at least five times this week.

1) Summarize the order of events in verses 1-16.

2) What do you know about Jesus' relationship with this family? (v. 5; John 12: 1-3; Luke 10:38)

3) Why are the disciples reluctant to go back to Judea? (see John 7:1)

4) What does Jesus mean in verses 9 & 10?

5) How is death like falling asleep?

6) How and why do the disciples misunderstand Jesus? (vv. 12-13, 16)

7) What purpose does Jesus ascribe to Lazarus' illness?

8) Why does Jesus wait to go to Bethany?

9) Read and meditate on Psalm 116. How does Jesus Christ deliver your soul from death, your eyes from tears, and your feet from stumbling?

10) How can God be glorified through an illness even if physical healing does not happen?
