

Quiet Time Study: John 13: 18-30

***Pray:** Ask the LORD to help you love discipline, knowledge, and correction. (Proverbs 12:1)

***Read:** Read through the passage at least two times each day this week. Review John 13: 1-17.

- 1) What are the main points of this passage?

- 2) For what purpose does Jesus tell His disciples about the betrayal that is about to occur? (v. 19)

- 3) Why was it important for the disciples to hear what Jesus says in verse 20?

- 4) What is the significance of Jesus' action in verses 26 & 27?

- 5) What was Satan's role in this event? (see Luke 22:1-6)

- 6) Why was Judas vulnerable to Satan's promptings?

7) What does it reveal about the character of Jesus Christ that He knowingly chose and loved His betrayer?

8) What is your response to the fact that Jesus knows you and loves you completely?

9) Read the following Scriptures. What instruction is given for you to be on guard against Satan?

*Ephesians 6:10-18

*James 4:1-8

10) The Lord Jesus quotes Psalm 41: 9. Read Psalm 41 and meditate on the ways this psalm reflects Jesus' experience during His ministry before His crucifixion and resurrection.
