

**Quiet Time Study: John 14: 1-14**

**\*Pray:** Ask the LORD to help you set your heart and mind on things above. (Colossians 3:1,2)

**\*Read:** Read through the passage at least two times each day this week.

1) Review John 13. Detail why the disciples are troubled.

2) What does Jesus tell them to do instead?

3) What promises does Jesus make in verses 2 & 3? Why are these truths significant for the believer?

4) What two questions do the disciples have? (verse 5)

5) Explain the significance of Jesus' answer to Thomas in verses 6 & 7.

Why is this truth so difficult for people to accept?

6) What basis for belief does Jesus give in verses 10 & 11?

7) List what you know of God the Father's character based on what you've observed in Jesus Christ in the Gospel of John.

8) What work has the Father been doing through the Son?

9) Consider John 15:9-17 & 16:23-28. What is the context of Jesus' promise in 14:13,14 that He will do whatever you ask in His name?

10) How does this passage impact your faith in Jesus Christ?

11) Meditate on Psalm 4. Thank the LORD that He has set you apart for Himself through Jesus Christ.
