

## **Quiet Time Study: John 15: 1-11**

**\*Pray:** Ask the LORD to give you a hunger and thirst for righteousness. (Matthew 5:6)

**\*Read:** Read through the passage at least two times each day this week. Review John 14.

1) What is the main point of this passage?

2) How is Jesus the true vine?

3) Who are the branches? What two kinds of branches described in this passage?

4) What does it mean to be clean? (verse 3) How is a person made clean? (see John 3:18; 13:10; 14:6; 17:17)

5) What does it mean to remain in Christ? (verses 9,10; see also John 6:53-64 & 1 John 2:20-27)

6) Consider the following passages. How can you pursue obedience to Christ?

\*John 15:10

\*John 14:23, 26 & 16:3

\*Romans 6: 5-14

\*Romans 8: 1-17

\*Romans 12: 1-2

\*Ephesians 4: 17-24

\*Ephesians 6: 10-18

\*Philippians 3: 7-11

\*Colossians 3: 1-10

7) What is the purpose of bearing much fruit and being Christ's disciples? (verse 8)

8) What is the relationship between remaining and receiving what you ask in His name?

9) What is the significance of Jesus' statement in verse 11?

10) What other "vines" of this world tempt you away from abiding in the True Vine?
