4) What must Jesus endure as a result of becoming the sacrifice for sin and receiving the full penalty for the sins of the world?

5) Why do the soldiers and officials fall to the ground in verse 6?

6) Why does Jesus twice ask who they want?

7) Describe and explain Peter's reaction in verse 10.

8) What is your reaction to the fact that Jesus knew all that was going to happen to Him (verse 4) and chose to endure all of it?

9) What do these events teach you about the character of Jesus Christ?

10) Meditate on Psalm 71. Consider the anguish and faithfulness of your Savior as He anticipated the cross.
